

2007 Reno Wheelmen Event Reimbursement Policy

Race Events (Road, Mountain, and Cyclocross)

Any Reno Wheelmen member can be reimbursed for up to 10 race events* each year as follows:

Cat 3/4/5 Road; Beg/Sport MTB; All Cyclocross	\$30
Cat 2 Road; Expert MTB	\$40
Cat 1 Road; Semi-Pro/Pro MTB	\$50

*Reimbursable race events must be USCF, NORBA, or OBRA sanctioned

*Events sponsored by the Reno Wheelmen are not reimbursable (e.g. Twilight Series, Peavine Challenge, etc.)

The above amounts per race will be reimbursed regardless of the actual race entry fee paid. Stage races can be counted as a single event, or each stage (excluding prologue) can be claimed individually, subject to the overall limit on the number of race events.

TeamRW members are eligible for reimbursement for an **additional 6 race events (16 total)**. In addition, if a member races at least 6 races with TeamRW, he/she can claim a **\$100 clothing reimbursement**.

Touring Events (Century Rides, Death Ride, etc.)

In addition to the race events above, members can be reimbursed for up to 2 touring events each year, \$30 each event. Events sponsored by the Reno Wheelmen are not reimbursable.

Officials

Any Reno Wheelmen member that is a USCF/NORBA licensed official can be reimbursed for their annual license fee (\$35). Use the "Other" line of the reimbursement request form to document this request.

Reimbursement Requirements and Eligibility

In order to be reimbursed for a given event, a rider must:

1. wear a current-year club jersey during the event
2. enter Reno Wheelmen as the Club/Team on the race entry form
3. actually participate in the event and make every reasonable effort to complete it
4. write a race report for the event and post it to the renowheelmen@yahoogroups.com listserv.

In order to qualify for any event reimbursement, the rider must:

1. be a current club member (dues paid for year of reimbursement)
2. be an active member by attending meetings, training rides, and other club activities
3. provide **substantial help** with duties related to one of the club-sponsored events, such as:
 - a. NCNCA District Time Trial (Event Planning, Course Set-up, Registration/Results, Clean-up)
 - b. Peavine Challenge (Event Planning, Course Marking, Registration/Results, Clean-up)
 - c. Tour de Nez (Course Marshall)
 - d. Twilight Road, MTB, or CX Series (Series Promoter, Race Director, Course Marshall)
 - e. Trail Work with Dale Beesmer (Peavine, Hidden Valley)

Reimbursement

Financial reimbursement will take place annually. Members should list events on the Reimbursement Request Form and submit to the club treasurer by December 31, 2007 for reimbursement by January 31, 2008. Requests may be turned in early, but reimbursements will only be paid in January 2008. Members should indicate on the reimbursement request form that all eligibility requirements have been met and should list the duty performed to fulfill the "substantial help" requirement.

The total dollar amount paid by the club for reimbursement for the 2007 race year will be capped at \$1000 for regular members and \$6500 for TeamRW members. If valid reimbursement requests are received from either group in excess of its respective cap, all reimbursements within that group will be proportionally reduced so as not to exceed that cap.
