DIRECTIONS:

Keystone: North on North Virginia Street, just past Bonanza Casino turn left on Hoge Road, take to end, continue on dirt.

Peavine Hill Climb: Take US 395 north towards Stead, take Stead Blvd south, turn right on North Virginia Street, after 1/2 mile turn left on the Peavine Access Road, park before the railroad tracks.
