This event is a fundraiser for the [Tahoe Mountain Bike Patrol](#), a non-profit organization providing education and assistance to all trail users. Donations fund equipment, medical supplies, and first aid training for patrollers.

COURSE: The course is 20 miles with 3300' of climbing. All categories do the same course. Starting near Spooner Lake at an elevation of 7000', the course is North Canyon Road, around Marlette Lake, across the Marlette Flume Trail, over Tunnel Creek Road to the Red House Flume, and up to the new Sunflower Hill Trail to the Tahoe Rim Trail at 8330'. Descending the TRT to Hobart Road and on down to Marlette Lake where the final climb takes them to the finish line at the top (saddle) of North Canyon Road. *After the finish line*, there is a 4 mile downhill ride back to the start to make the total distance 24 miles for the day. It is important that riders control their speed and yield to other trail users through this section.

RACE DETAILS: Check online registration for a list of all categories and age groups. Racers meeting at 9:20am, Race starts at 9:30am in 1-minute waves by category. Helmets required. Five riders to make a class, smaller classes may be combined. Awards to three places in all categories. \$250 Pro/Cat 1 purse for fastest times. Post event awards ceremony and product raffle from our awesome sponsors. Super Burrito lunch provided for all racers.

REGISTRATION: Registration available online at www.BikeReg.com for \$40 (Women and Junior categories are \$30). Online registration closes on Thursday, August 22 at 8pm PDT. \$10 late fee for same day registration. Registration/Number pick-up opens at 7:45am, closes at 9:00am.

DIRECTIONS: Spooner Lake State Park is located at [3709 Nevada Hwy 28, Glenbrook, NV](#). There is limited parking (first 50 racer vehicles) within the park for a fee (\$10/vehicle, \$8/vehicle for Nevada residents), please try to carpool. Gates open at 7am. Overflow parking is located in the 'Sno-Park' area across Hwy 28 approximately 1/4 mile south of the park entrance and the dirt lot at the north west corner of Hwy 28 and Hwy 50. Please obey traffic laws and ride single file when riding on Hwy 28. The \$2 bike-in entrance fee is being covered by the event for all pre-registered riders. Please be prepared to pay the walk-in or bike-in fee for all others. These fees go directly to supporting the park!
